MARKUP NOTICE

The Committee on Financial Services will meet in open session on Wednesday, October 14, 2009, (and subsequent days if necessary) at 10 a.m. in room 2128 Rayburn House Office Building to consider the following measures:

- (1) October 2, 2009 Discussion Draft of the Over-the-Counter Derivatives Markets Act of 2009;
- (2) September 25, 2009 Discussion Draft of the Consumer Financial Protection Agency Act of 2009 (to be reported as H.R. 3126);
- (3) H.R. 3763, to amend the Fair Credit Reporting Act to provide for an exclusion from Red Flag Guidelines for certain businesses; and
- (4) H.R. 3606, to amend the Truth in Lending Act to make a technical correction to an amendment made by the Credit CARD Act of 2009.

Managers amendments are expected on the first two measures and will be distributed as soon as possible.

The Chair will provide priority in recognition for purposes of offering an amendment to Members who file 100 copies of the amendment with the Committee's General Counsel not later than 4:30 p.m. on Tuesday, October 13, 2009, in room 2129 Rayburn House Office Building. Electronic copies of amendments should also be e-mailed to Tom.Duncan@mail.house.gov in order to facilitate distribution of amendments to Member offices.

The Chair announces that he may postpone record votes on amendments to the measure to be considered pursuant to the rules of the Committee and the House. Members are reminded that, pursuant to the Chair's policy regarding postponed votes, it is important that Members inform the Chair of potential amendments as soon as possible to ensure that they are not prejudiced in the offering of amendments through the use of this authority.
